At Sarawak Skills, the first half of 2021 presented us with numerous opportunities to advance the noble cause of Human Capital Development. Notwithstanding the challenges brought about by the the COVID-19 pandemic, we have been able to draw on our collective strengths and talents to strengthen our teaching, training and learning ecosystem. In line with the dizzying speed of technological change, we have also intensified our effort(s) to explore new frontiers to facilitate the development of an agile, future-ready workforce.

In this edition of our newsletter, we are pleased to share with you a number of highlights over the past six months. On 8 March 2021, we celebrated the appointment of the Right Honourable Datuk Patinggi (Dr) Abang Haji Abdul Rahman Zohari bin Tun Datuk Abang Haji Openg, Chief Minister of Sarawak as the First Chancellor of i-CATS University College. This was followed by the official launch of i-CATS University College by the Chief Minister. On behalf of the Sarawak Skills family, I wish to thank our Chief Minister for his tremendous support over the years.

During the first quarter of 2021, i-CATS University College, together with six other institutions of higher learning entered into a Memorandum of Collaboration with Serba Dinamik Group Berhad to establish a New Space Economy Nexus (NSEN). This paves the way for the parties to develop various space technology applications, e.g. to bridge the digital divide by providing satellite broadband connectivity especially in remote and rural areas. For the Sarawak Skills Group of Learning Institutions, an important part of this collaboration will be the development of academic and skills programmes to support the space industry.

Following the launch of our inaugural industry talk/webinar in December 2020, three industry talks were organized in the first half of 2021. This is part of our ongoing effort to bring together the relevant stakeholders 'under one roof' and facilitate the transformation of Sarawak's economic, educational and digital landscape in line with the Sarawak Post COVID-19 Development Strategy 2030.

With the phased reopening of the various sectors of our economy, the continued support of our stakeholders comprising the government, various sectors of industry, parents, alumni, students and staff members will enable us to remain true to our mission, i.e. to produce a qualified and competent workforce through continuous learning and development.

Sarawak Skills/i-CATS University

For the 742 graduates of the Class of 2020, their family members and the entire Sarawak Skills family, it was a convocation like no other.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it was not possible to have a single convocation ceremony for all graduates from across the Sarawak Skills Group of Learning Institutions.

On 8 March 2021, the Right Honourable Datuk Patinggi (Dr) Abang Haji Abdul Rahman Zohari bin Tun Datuk Abang Haji Openg, Chief Minister of Sarawak officiated at a Special Session for the conferment of certificates, diplomas and bachelor's degrees followed by the presentation of industry awards to selected graduates. Held at i-CATS University College (i-CATS UC) in Kuching, there was much to celebrate - the achievements of the graduates, appointment of the Chief Minister as the First Chancellor of i-CATS UC followed by the launch of i-CATS UC by the Chief Minister. In line with COVID-19 Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), most of the graduates observed the ceremony live through Sarawak Skills' social media platforms.

In his address, the Chief Minister expressed his appreciation to the i-CATS UC Board of Governors for inviting him to be the first Chancellor of i-CATS UC. With regard to human resource development or capacity building, the Chief Minister emphasized that Sarawak needed to provide special skills training to produce more skilled manpower in order to develop the hydrogen economy. He stated that the world was moving towards clean energy consumption with the expectation that hydrogen gas would be the main source of energy in the coming decades.

In this respect, he highlighted, "Sarawak needs to provide institutions such as universities, vocational institutions, and special training centres to generate the required skills in this new technology. And I believe that institutions such as the Sarawak Skills Development Centre (Sarawak Skills) and International College of Advanced Technology Sarawak (i-CATS) University College can play a role to produce skilled manpower or specialists in various new technologies including the development of the use of hydrogen gas and digital technologies that are the catalyst for today's economy."

The Chief Minister also shared that the Sarawak government wanted more Sarawakian students to master aero-technology. In this respect, he revealed that the government would upgrade the facilities at i-CATS UC which would focus on the development of technological knowledge, research, engineering and aero technology. This would go a long way to further strengthen Sarawak's digital economy. He added that he would do his best to contribute to the development of i-CATS UC and hoped that in five years' time, the university college would have a much better campus like the other universities in Sarawak.

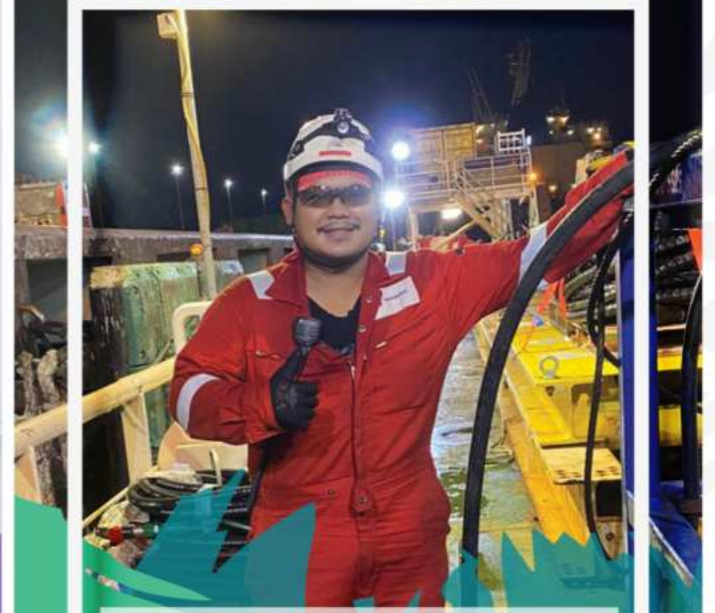

College 23rd Convocation

LAUNCH OF *i*-CATS UNIVERSITY COLLEGE



i-CATS University College Offers Partial Tuition Fee Waiver for New Students Joining Diploma and Degree Programmes in July and August 2021

In conjunction with the launch of *i*-CATS University College (*i*-CATS UC) on 8 March 2021 by Chief Minister Datuk Patinggi (Dr) Abang Haji Abdul Rahman Zohari bin Tun Datuk Abang Haji Openg, students who register for the various diploma and bachelor's degree programmes during its Special Info, Scholarship cum Registration Days will receive an attractive discount on their first year's tuition fee. Essentially, this will be a partial tuition fee waiver amounting to 20 percent of the first year's tuition fee.

In this respect, *i*-CATS UC highlighted that the Special Info, Scholarship cum Registration Days have been scheduled throughout July and August 2021. In line with the Government's directives under Phase 2 of the National Recovery Plan, the aforementioned events will be held online (via Facebook Live: ICATS, Google Meet or Zoom).

The academic programmes offered at its purpose-built campus at Jalan Stampin Timur in Kuching span a wide range of disciplines, i.e. Accounting and Business, Engineering, Hospitality and Tourism, Plantation Management, and Software Engineering. In addition to diploma-level programmes in the aforementioned disciplines, *i*-CATS UC offers a Foundation in Management programme, and bachelor's degree programmes in Business Administration (E-Commerce), Software Engineering, and Tourism and Hospitality.

Besides the aforementioned partial tuition fee waiver, SPM school leavers with five (5) credits in SPM/SPMV are encouraged to take up the zero-tuition fee offer for the Foundation in Management programme, a gateway to bachelor's degree programmes offered at *i*-CATS UC. Through its one-stop centre, the university college also provides assistance to students in their application(s) for study loans from the National Higher Education Fund Corporation (Perbadanan Tabung Pendidikan Tinggi Nasional – PTPN), or the Sarawak Foundation (Yayasan Sarawak).



With regard to financial assistance from Yayasan Sarawak, students who meet the prescribed requirements will be offered a Scholarship-Loan which covers the course fees and monthly living allowance. Indeed, these various forms of financial assistance will go a long way towards alleviating the financial burden of many families who are affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. 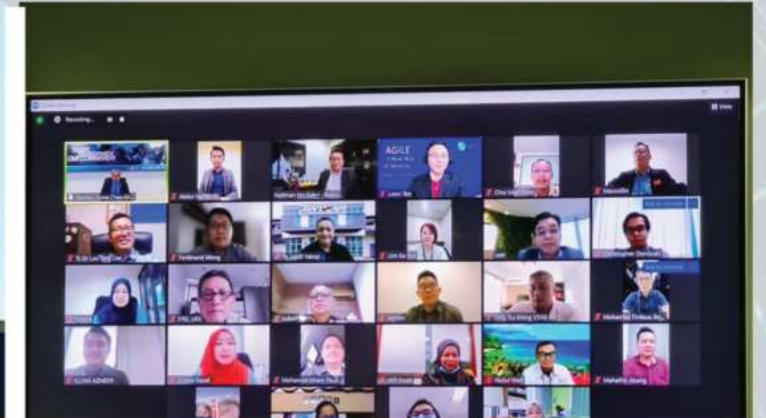

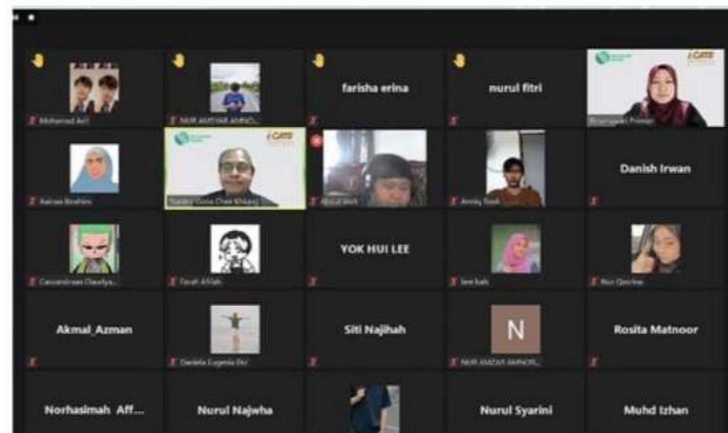

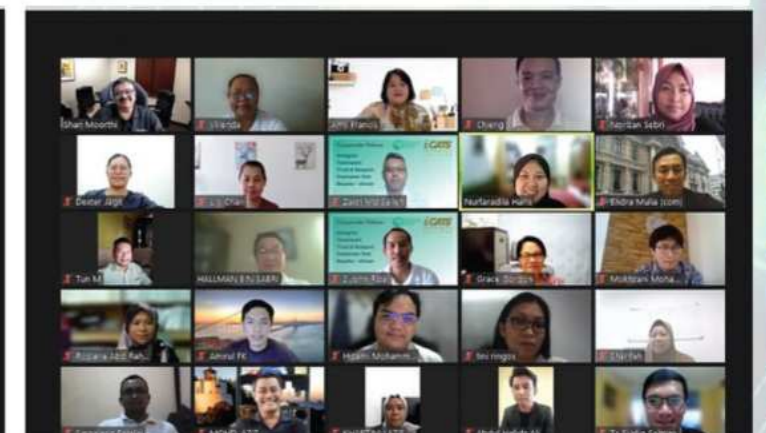
