



n 21 September 2023, the Sarawak Skills Group of Learning Institutions (Sarawak Skills) received three prestigious awards during the Malaysia Education & TVET Awards Ceremony 2023.

The awards ceremony was held in conjunction with the ASEAN HR Excellence Awards 2023 at the Mandarin Oriental Kuala Lumpur. Officiated by Yang Berhormat Tuan Mustapha @ Mohd Yunus bin Sakmud, Deputy Minister of Human Resources, Ministry of Human Resources Malaysia, the three awards bestowed on Sarawak Skills are, namely Malaysia's in Skills Training (Organization Excellence - Presented to the Sarawak Skills Development Centre), Outstanding TVET Personality Award (Leadership - Presented to Mr. Hallman bin Sabri, Executive Director of the Sarawak Skills Group of Learning Institutions) and Best TVET Training Provider (Automotive & Welding - Presented to the Automotive and Welding Institute of Sarawak (AWISAR)).
